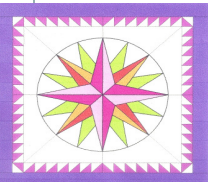
CLASSES AND MORE



Sand & Sea Quilt

Do you like the look of blocks on the diagonal but hate to piece the side triangles.

Janet Fawcett will teach you the "Straight To The Point" technique developed by Susan Mayer. You can enjoy making this quilt in a snap. You will also learn what block patterns work and how to plan for larger bed size quilts using this technique.
